New Family/Student Schedule

- Annual tuition may be paid in full or in installments.
- Tuition is paid through direct withdrawal from your designated checking or savings account.
- **Fees and Deposits are payable by check or authorized debit and are non-refundable.**
- **Fees are not included in annual tuition.**

Children's Garden Montessori School is non-profit and dependent upon tuition payments for all operating funds.

Students are accepted for the entire school year. If a child leaves Children's Garden prior to the end of the school year, the parents are responsible for tuition payment in full. No reduction in the yearly tuition can be allowed for absence, withdrawal, or dismissal during the school year. The application, enrollment, deposits and tuition payments are non-refundable.
