

DEAR FAMILIES.

Great news! We're pleased to let you know that as of September 1, 2021 your child can receive tuition from the Denver Preschool Program (DPP) for the 2021-2022 school year.

Thanks to Denver voters, preschool tuition support is available to **all families**—regardless of income—who have a child who is 4-years-old by October 1 and lives within the City and County of Denver.

The typical child will receive \$788, but the amount of tuition that DPP will pay on your behalf **can range from \$58 to \$1,385 per month**.

The amount of tuition support your family can receive is determined by:



Your household income



Your school's quality rating



How many hours your child attends
