

Tuition Support Eligibility

The Denver Preschool Program (DPP) is a local nonprofit that helps all families living in the City and County of Denver save money on preschool. Because DPP is funded through a dedicated city sales tax, **every** Denver family with a child in their year before kindergarten qualifies for tuition credits regardless of their income.

Use this chart to determine eligibility for when a child can start receiving tuition support based on their birthdate.

To Be Eligible for Tuition Support:

- > Child must live in the City and County of Denver
- > Child must attend a DPP-participating preschool

All family income levels are eligible.
